

MINUTES FROM THE DECEMBER 18, 2025 MEETING OF THE GREEN SPRING COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by Mayor John Morton. In attendance were City Commissioners Mike Faith, Chris von Allmen, and Stuart Ries, along with City Attorney Chip Hayward and City Clerk Caryl Graf. Commissioner Trevor Cravens was not present.

The Security Report was emailed and contained no significant events.

A motion was made by Ries Commissioner to approve the minutes as written from the November meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Faith. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

BEAUTIFICATION, Commissioner Chris von Allmen

- The city was decorated for the holidays.
- Final leaf cleanup has occurred
- Dog stations – Connected with Proturf to make sure that these are being serviced in the winter. They have since been emptied by Pro Turf.
- Tree City USA – next year will require a Tree City USA flag to be visible while Mayor is reading proclamation.

CITY SERVICES, Commissioner Mike Faith

11/24 Resident complaint received for Quail Brace Court. The concern was forwarded to Rumpke for review. Rumpke investigated the report and confirmed that a crew member visited the residence to ensure the garbage was collected.

Rumpke advised that service includes either up to three 30-gallon containers collected from the rear door, or one 95-gallon Rumpke cart collected at the curb at no charge. If a resident prefers rear door collection using a 95-gallon Rumpke cart, that service is available for an additional \$3.50 per month, billed quarterly to the resident.

Based on the information provided, it appears the resident may have expected rear door collection with the 95-gallon cart at no charge. I followed up with the resident for clarification but did not receive a response.

Additional Note - I was very impressed with our snow plowing efforts during the last two snow incidents.

FINANCE, Commissioner Stuart Ries

Income for November was \$63,887.20. This includes \$18,347.74 from insurance premium tax receipts and \$44,622.24 from property tax receipts. Expenses for November were \$20,375.06. Major November expenses were Trash Collection (\$7,935.00) and Lawn Care (\$7188.00).

2025 Property Taxes: 260 of 278 (93.5%) property owners have paid 2025 taxes. The face amount is due December 31, 2025.

New Business: The Municipal Order 2025-01 establishing an investment policy for the City of Green Spring and Municipal Resolution 2025-01 authorizing participation in the KY League of Cities Investment Pool.
